



GDC videos

Videos played an important part in the GuiDanCe project effort to communicate the activities organised by the project as well as raising the voice of signatory cities. They exhibit the role of the project in facilitating cooperation between European cities in the field of smart city and in building synergies between urban practitioners, decision-makers and stakeholder communities.

In total, **48 videos** were produced by our Barcelona-based subcontractor Vision Communication. Available on the Green Digital Charter's YouTube account, videos promote cities as organisations leading by example.



Green Digital Charter and Smart Cities (April 2016)

A first video was realised in Rennes to showcase the Green Digital Charter, and all three commitments it creates for signatory cities. The video shows

The video came right after the update of the Charter in 2015 and at the occasion of the signing of Rennes Métropole.



'Cities in Transition' GDC roadshow (January 2017)

Untitled 'Cities in Transition', GuiDanCe first roadshow brought together city representatives, politicians, EU officials and stakeholders for a day of dialogue and





interactive workshops about needs and priorities of cities in this digital transformation.







12 individual interviews gave the floor to politicians and urban practitioners attending the event (Bordeaux, Eindhoven, Ghent, Lisbon, Milan, Oulu, Rome, Rijeka and Zaragoza) as well as Mr Eddy Hartog, Head of Unit 'Smart Mobility' at the European Commission and KSF policy advisor Federica Bordelot.

GuiDanCe at Barcelona Smart City Expo (November 2017)

GuiDanCe was in Barcelona for the 2017 edition of the Smart City World Expo Congress (SCEWC). The project was part of the



European pavilion gathering all 13 current Smart Cities & Communities 'lighthouse' projects funded under the Horizon 2020 programme.

On the first day, GuiDanCe walked through the Expo to meet signatory cities exhibiting in Barcelona to provide them additional visibility. In addition to the large promotional video, 9 individual interviews express the views of city representatives on the Expo and share cities' visions and strategies (Barcelona, Bordeaux, Ghent, Nantes, London, Lyon, Tampere) as well as the added-value of EUROCITIES in facilitating exchanges between European cities (Bernadett Degrendele, EUROCITIES).
