

GuiDanCe 2017 monitoring report

Two years after its first monitoring report, the Green Digital Charter and GuiDanCe project released in January 2018 a second edition to document the progress of GDC signatory cities towards their commitment to use digital technologies to meet their energy goals and contribute to the fight against climate change.

Based on evidence collected through an email survey and interviews held with data officers and smart city project managers, the second implementation monitoring report confirms the trends previously identified and highlights new challenges for urban practitioners.

The reader is invited to navigate through concrete measures and projects implemented by GDC signatory cities to secure energy efficiency, reduce their overall carbon footprint while improving governance.

All cities have a different understanding of what a ‘smart city’ is. As such, the report draws on what makes them special while providing a comprehensive overview of the current situation across contributing cities.

Cities co-create, cities innovate, cities measure. And cities collaborate. Overall, cities are keen to improve by sharing experiences and best practices as well as opening knowledge gained through concrete measures. GuiDanCe second monitoring report attempts to feed this collective effort for mutual learning and strengthen collaboration between European cities.
